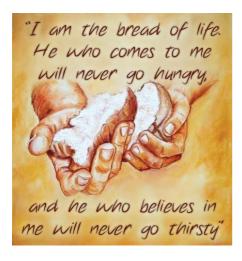


Spend a great weekend at Shalom and explore how making sourdough bread can be a very spiritual exercise as well as a metaphor for other aspects of our lives.
